EU CONTEXT

- In some countries, pressure is growing to demonstrate that practicing physicians continue to meet their specialty's standards.
- Physicians may be encouraged to engage in lifelong learning to continually update their knowledge and skills.
- Despite the increasing attention on doctor mobility, there remains a lack of European-level interest in ensuring the sustained competence of health professionals.



CONTEXT IN FRANCE (1/2)

The French Medical Council was at the initiative for a "recertification" procedure in France in 2016.

The French government is planning to introduce a form of recertification for new registrants from 2021 onwards.

There is currently a committee (14 members) installed in 2018 by the Ministry of health who have the mission to:

- Analyze the foreign models of recertification;
- Propose a structure of recertification in France;
- Describe tools for recertification;
- Identify legal regulation.

A report is expected in September 2018

The French Medical council is part of the committee



CONTEXT IN FRANCE (2/2)

Recertification implies a major shift in the regulation of medical practice in France.

Nowadays, in France, diploma is the essential condition to practice.

Key features at this stage for practicing doctors :

- Trial for volunteers in 2019;
- Recertification every 6 years Because CPD is mandatory every 3 years in France;
- No exam for doctors : no return to the University / no extra diploma required;
- Individual and personal approaches.






Question 1 :to the question " have you a recertification process for doctors in your country" answers from 13 CAs






Question 2 :on the 7 CAs offering recertification, is it mandatory?

QUESTION 2 : MAIN OUTCOMES (1/2)

- This result shows that the definitions and mechanisms of revalidation vary significantly across member states.
- A review of selected European countries, reveals diversity in approaches to ensuring physician competence. The outcome of these processes for example may be recertification or relicensure.



QUESTION 2 : MAIN OUTCOMES (2/2)

- Continuing medical education and CPD are the most widely used approaches.
- Recertification may include other tools, for instance activity, practice assessment.
- Forms of recertification may also include managerial, social and personal skills.
