Cause, objective & principles

- The Registratiecommissie Geneeskundig Specialisten (RGS) of the KNMG is the competent authority with regard to the registration of medical specialists
- Periodical review by the RGS of all of its fees
 - Review of spring 2019: the RGS-fee on applications for recognition and registration by foreign specialists does not nearly match the costs
- New fee(s) to be established, based on the following principles:
 - The new fee covers the actual costs per application
 - The new fee in itself does not lead to an infringement of the free movement of services
 - The new fee falls within the range of fees other Member States impose (benchmark)

Survey

- As the RGS is the competent authority with regard to the recognition and registration of medical specialists(-diplomas), we have requested you to distinguish between (if applicable):
 - Fees for basic medical qualification and specialist qualification
 - Fees for recognition of qualification and registration of the applicant
 - Fees for automatic recognition, general system and non-EU applications
- Of all ENMCA members, we received 13 reactions (March 2019)

Conclusion

- Wide variety of fees and wide variety in activities the fees are composed of:
 - Authorities have established separate fees for recognition, registration or both
 - Some authorities distinguish between automatic recognition, general system and non-EU; some authorities do not
- Difficult to draw conclusions from this survey because:
 - Activities that are undertaken to assess an application may differ per authority/MS
 - Some authorities may be subsidized and some may not
 - Some authorities have established the same fees for non-nationals as for their own nationals and some have not.
