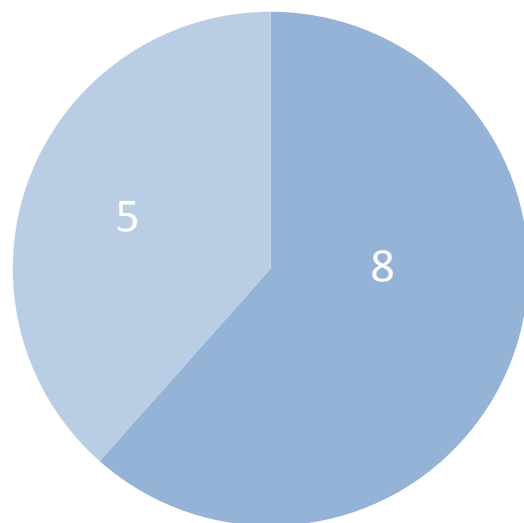

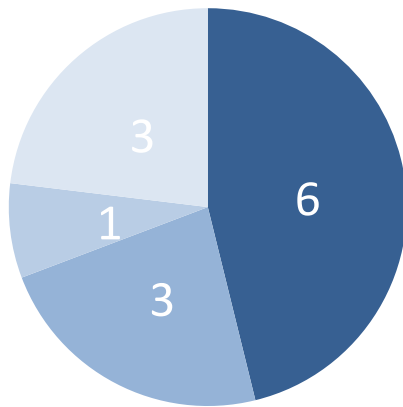
1. Number of competent authorities

- Several authorities



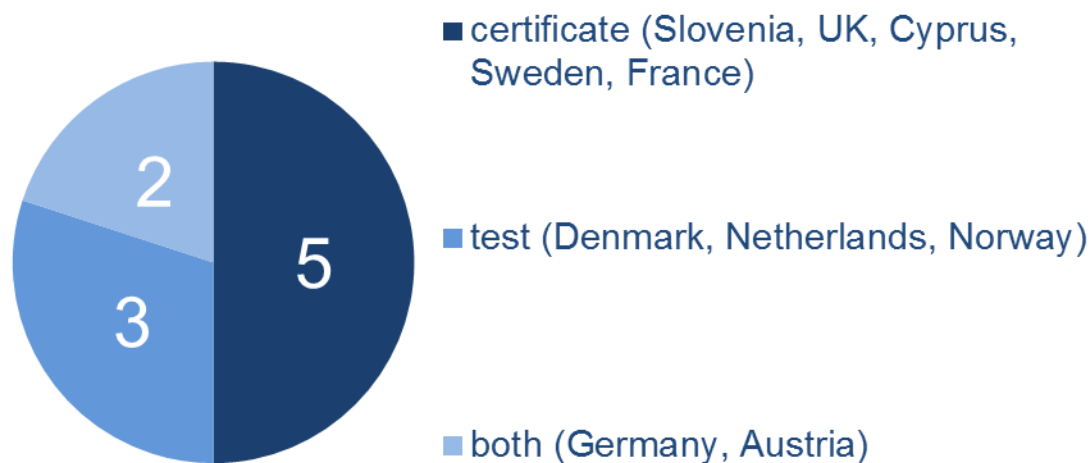
Which level of language skills is required to practise as a doctor?

- none (Estonia, Iceland, Malta)

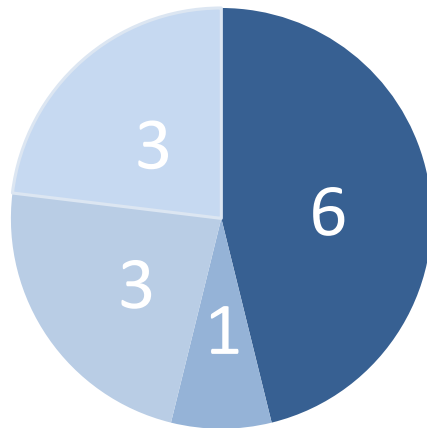


How do doctors prove their language competency?





Are general language skills or medical language skills required?



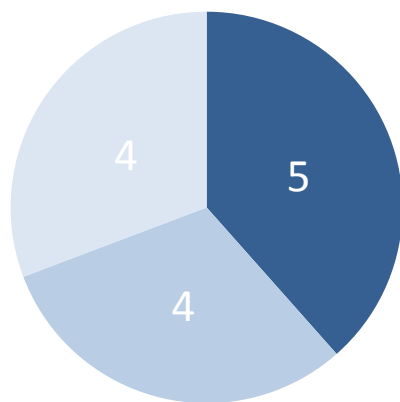

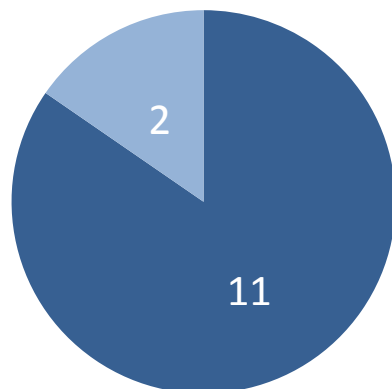

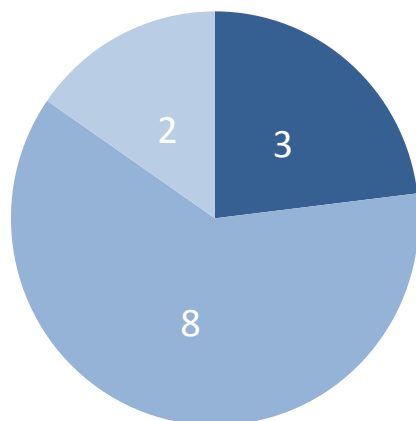

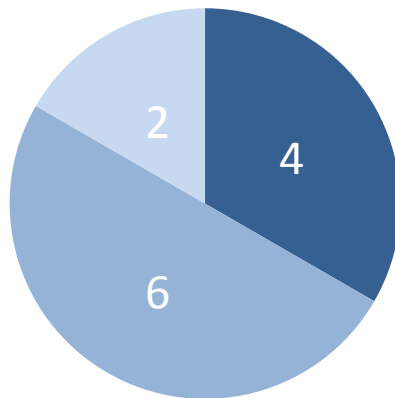

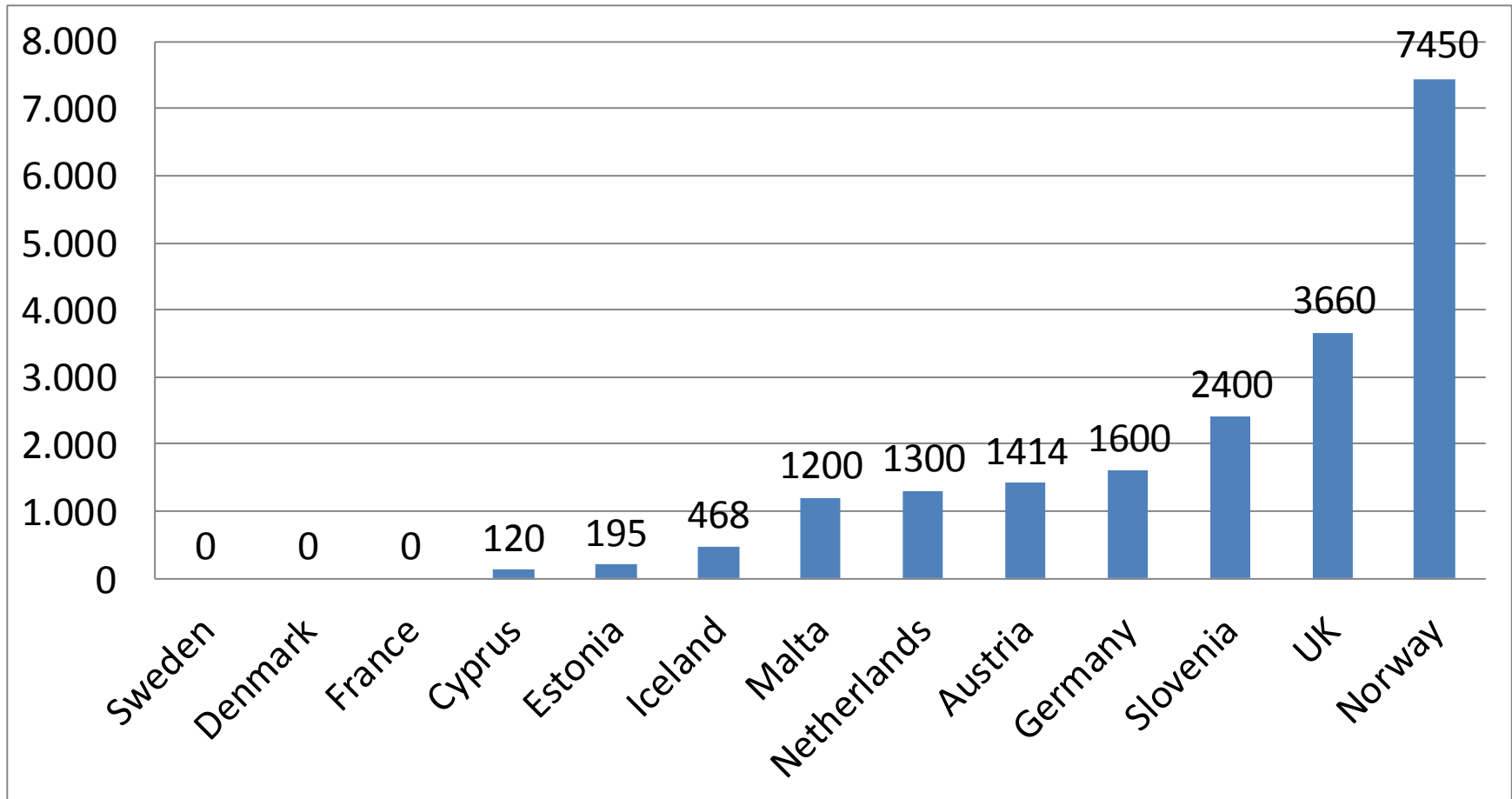

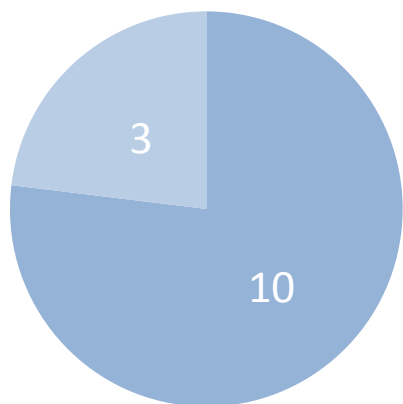

Who covers the costs?



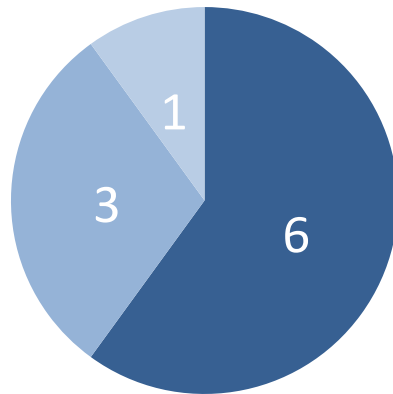
- all fees are paid by the applicant
